

## **Itinerant Music Programme at Elmwood in 2019**

At Elmwood, we have an out-of-school-hours Itinerant Music programme which is funded by the Ministry of Education. Specialist music teachers provide tuition in: violin, cello, clarinet and flute.

During the first week of term 1, a notice will be given to all year 3 children about the opportunity to learn violin in this programme to take home to discuss with their parents.

Year 4, 5, 6 children **who are interested** in learning violin or cello or clarinet or flute will be given a letter to take home to discuss with their parents.

**Filled in cut-off slips must be returned to the Elmwood School Office by Monday 04 February 2019.**

In the following couple of weeks, the music tutors will come to Elmwood to audition the children who have shown interest in learning one of these instruments. A notice will be sent home as to when this audition will take place.

**Please note that there are limited places.**

The children who do attain a place in the programme, must make a commitment for one year, starting in approximately week 4 of term 1 and finishing at approximately week 7 of term 4. Parents are encouraged to support their children at the lessons.

There are some instruments available for hire through Elmwood, at a minimal rate.

This programme of musical tuition supports our Elmwood Orchestra.
